The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Murphy gave a report on the Southern Iowa Trolley, Mental Health and Case Management meetings he attended.

Ambrose reported that the roof should be going on the Law Enforcement Center today.

Horton reported a problem with a ditch near Vintage Park in Lenox. The Board will go look at it and see what needs to be done to correct it.

Murphy reported that the door came in last week for the public nurse's office.

Horton reported on the ambulance board meeting he attended. County employees being volunteers for the ambulance was discussed.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approved the "Applications for Disabled Veterans Homestead Tax Credit" for parcels 004 2328400400 and 046 0701200200000 due to the law change to Iowa Code Section 35.1 allowing total disability rating based on individual unemployability paid at the 100% disability rate. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the Iowa Communities Assurance Pool proposed fiscal year 2016 insurance coverage.

Sheriff Josh Weed informed the Board that Chris Brooks will be leaving the end of the month and he will be going through the civil service process to find a replacement for the position.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
