The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Horton gave a report on the landfill meeting that he attended.

A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve the Class "C" liquor license for the Bedford Golf Club. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Claim Publishing List" dated March 26, 2015.

Horton and Ambrose reported that they looked at the ditch problem at the county owned property in Lenox. Options to correct the problem were discussed.

The Board visited with County Attorney Clint Spurrier about a problem reported in the unincorporated area of Taylor County in regard to problem with dogs. Chapter 351 states that if the dog doesn't have a tag and was killing another animal, the said dog could be killed. Ambrose let the person know what they could legally do to correct the situation.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
