After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Ambrose discussed the water pressure problem at the Law Enforcement Center. The Board will discuss this problem with Prochaska at the meeting on Thursday. The Board visited with Kenny Spencer from the City of Bedford, in regard to this problem.

The Board discussed the Dickinson County proposal to have the existing Iowa Master Matrix System repaired to include more local control for our county concerning the regulation, protection, and preservation of our county's natural resources. The Board is in favor of this proposal.
