The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Discussion was held on the water pressure at the Law Enforcement Center.

Four bids were received for moving & trimming services at 805 Home Avenue in Lenox from the following: Richard Williamson - \$100, Lincoln Lawn Care- \$65, Chad Bals - \$75 and Samo Lawn Care- \$65. The two lowest bids were the same so the board agreed to draw lots. Samo Lawn Care's name was drawn. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to accept the bid from Samo Lawn Care. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board visited with Kenny Spencer in regard to solutions to the water pressure problems. Spencer will talk to the Bedford City Water Board.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
