The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present. Jerry Murphy was absent.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Ambrose to abate \$6.00 taxes on parcel 054 000103200202000 owned by Burlington Northern Railroad. The motion carried 2-0.
