The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board approved claims to Frontier for \$697.09 for phone service and to Card Services for \$614.86 for freight on evidence lockers and battery backup costs.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the "County Line Agreement" with Ringgold County with regard to construction of a Farm-to-Market and Federal funded bridge removal and replacement project located on County Route P14 1.75 miles south of State Highway 2 crossing the Platte River. The motion carried 3-0.

A Law Enforcement Center Project meeting was held with the following present: Bill Huey, Shawn Kidell, Dustin Pittman, Ross Hullinger, Kenny Spencer, Josh Weed, Eric Moore, Jerry Murphy, Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose and Bonny Baker. The Board approved three change orders as follows:

CPR #7 - \$1,443.00 to furnish and install 1 5/8" track and studs with 5/8" gypsum board at north wall of laundry/jail issue storage 130.

CPR #8- \$1,568.00 to furnish and install 3 5/8" track and stud ceiling system with 5/8" gypsum board in rooms 123 & 124. Tape at level 4 & paint per plans.

CPR#9- \$1,189.00 to furnish labor and materials to accomplish the insulation modifications as shown & noted on drawing dated 3/18/15, sheets A4.2a and A4.2B.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
