The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

County Engineer Eldon Rike and Jim Rowe met with the Board. Cage-Free has asked Emergency Management for the portion of road at Yellowstone Avenue from 160th to 170th Street to be temporarily closed to help prevent disease to their chickens. Discussion was held on temporarily closing said road. Murphy was not in favor of closing road. A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Ambrose to close said road. Roll call vote: AYES: Horton & Ambrose NAYS: Murphy The motion carried 2-1.

Horton discussed the meeting he attended on data communication.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Claim Publishing List" dated May 7, 2015.

Sheriff Josh Weed visited with the Board in regard to the sheriff budget amendment.

A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve the budget amendment for publication. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to give approval for Auditor Bonny Baker to approve and submit the FY16 EMS grant application form on the iowagrants.gov website. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the transfer of \$6,231 from the Assessor FICA Fund to the Assessor Fund and to transfer \$6,774.66 from the Assessor IPERS Fund to the Assessor's Fund. The motion carried 3-0.

Angela Green met with the Board in regard to the increase of costs for soil analysis.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
