The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy, and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting also approved the minutes of the last meeting.

Eldon Rike presented a Supplemental Agreement for Final Design Services from Calhoun-Burns and Associates. The plans are for Bridge No Platte 17 (FHWA 323390) in Platte Township section 33. The new plans call for a 100' slab of continuous concrete. The new bridge is estimated to cost \$450,000 to construct, 80% of the funding will come from federal dollars. Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve the Supplemental Agreement for Final Design Services for bridge Platte 17 (FHWA 323390). Motion carried 3-0.

EMA Director, Mick Ware was in to ask the Board about designating spots in the county for the life flight helicopters to land. Ware will visit with each community to see where the best locations would be, and report back. He will also gather figures for construction of the pads.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
