The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Jerry Murphy, Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

The Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Martin Jones met with the Board in regard to the internet usage. Questions were answered by Kevin Cabbage from Farmers Mutual Telephone Company by phone. The group agreed that 10 MB will be the speed to purchase for the county. The amount could be adjusted if needed. This is unlimited usage.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to approve Resolution **2017-06**. This resolution transfers \$66,357.50 from the Rural Service Fund to the Secondary road fund. This amount includes \$6,323.33 deposited in the Rural Service Fund by Local Option Sales & Services Tax. The motion carried 3-0.

Ambrose gave a report on the Workforce Development meeting he attended.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
