The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy, and Auditor Clerk Sue Cox present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting also approved the minutes of the last meeting.

Claims were approved for payment.

Clint Spurrier presented the contract for the agreement between Conservation and Public Health. There was discussion on this agreement and they will wait to hear if Public Health or Conservation have additions or corrections.

Clint Spurrier asked to purchase a new computer for his department for \$983.00. The Board approved for Clint to purchase the computer.

The Board also spoke with County Attorney Spurrier about the Opioid Epidemic litigation. Tabled for Monday's meeting.

Sheriff Weed met with the Board and advised that the insurance will be giving them \$14,800 for the vehicle that was wrecked. There is a \$600 deductible. This was tabled until Monday discussion. Sheriff Weed will compare vehicles that are available for Monday's meeting for approval of buying a used vehicle to replace this totaled vehicle.

The Board approved the Resolution 2018-09 for transfer to Secondary Roads. Murphy approved Ambrose seconded to transfer \$68,830.16 to the Secondary Roads fund in this transfer \$5436.94 are funds from Local Option Sales and Service Tax. 3-0 Approved.

Jim Rowe from Secondary Roads met with the Board to discuss City of Blockton shed. He said the county does not own the land or the building so Secondary Roads will take it off the insurance and let the City of Blockton have the shed back for their use.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
