The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy, and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting also approved the minutes of the last meeting.

Ambrose reported on the Conservation Board Meeting he attended. The Conservation Board is willing to give the joint Sanitarian/Conservation job a try.
