The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, and Auditor Clerk Sue Cox present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

Ambrose mentioned that Mr. Hawhee asked to be able to put a bench in the courtyard in memorial of Jill Poppa. There was no objection noted.

Eldon Rike met with the board reference utility permit for Alliant west of Clearfield. They will put a line under 160th and Yellowstone Ave. Ambrose motioned and Murphy seconded. Board approved 3-0.
