The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to approve the "Secondary Road Monthly Transfer Resolution **2017-04**." This resolution is to notify the treasurer to transfer from the rural service fund to the secondary road fund \$66,357.50. This amount includes \$6,323.32 deposited in the rural service fund by local option sales & services tax. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to adopt Resolution **2017-05**. This resolution adopts the Taylor County Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan. The adoption of this legitimizes the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan. The motion carried 3-0 and the Taylor County Board of Supervisors will submit this Adoption Resolution to the Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Department and Federal Emergency Management Agency Region VII officials to enable the plan's final approval.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
