The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy, and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve Drew Esque and Raven Morris to be full time dispatchers this will become effective September 24, 2017. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the estimates for the replacement of the roof on the garage at the old Sheriff's Office. The first estimate was from Simmons Restoration for \$2,958.33 the second was from Hensley Innovations for \$2700.00. Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to approve Hensley Innovations to replace the roof at the old Sheriff's Office. Motion carried 3-0.

Allan Garey was present to discuss a bridge that the weight limit had recently been lowered on. The bridge is on 110th Street between Browning and Denver Avenue. Jim Rowe joined the meeting and let the Board and Mr. Garey know that the bridge is scheduled for repair, but is not sure of the timeline at this time.

Ambrose made a motion second by Murphy to approve the Quit Claim Deed to the Lenox Community School District. Motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
