The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy, and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to purchase a flammable cabinet for the janitorial department. Motion carried 3-0.

Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to approve payment for Bi –State Electronics for \$85.00 and Pitney Bowes for \$79.25. Motion carried 3-0.

Sheriff, Josh Weed was present to ask the Board to extend the time allowed to take vacation for one employee. The Sheriff's Department has been understaffed and has not allowed an employee to take vacation time. Ambrose made a motion seconded by Horton that due to extenuating circumstances (the shortage of dispatchers) the Board will extend the period for taking vacation time from the employee's anniversary date November 9<sup>th</sup> allowing until January 31<sup>st</sup>. If not used by then the vacation time will be lost. Motion carried 3-0.
