The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to approve **Resolution 2017-03**. This resolution transfers \$66,357.50 from the rural services fund to the secondary road fund. This amount includes \$7,369.85 deposited in the rural service fund from the local option sales and services tax. The motion carried 3-0.

Joan Gallagher opened bids for the freezer in the public health department. Misha Curtis has the highest bid for \$125. Gallagher will notify her.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve the Taylor County Conservation Board's approval for a 90 day pay increase for Nick Fehring to \$45,000 effective October 1, 2016. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
